



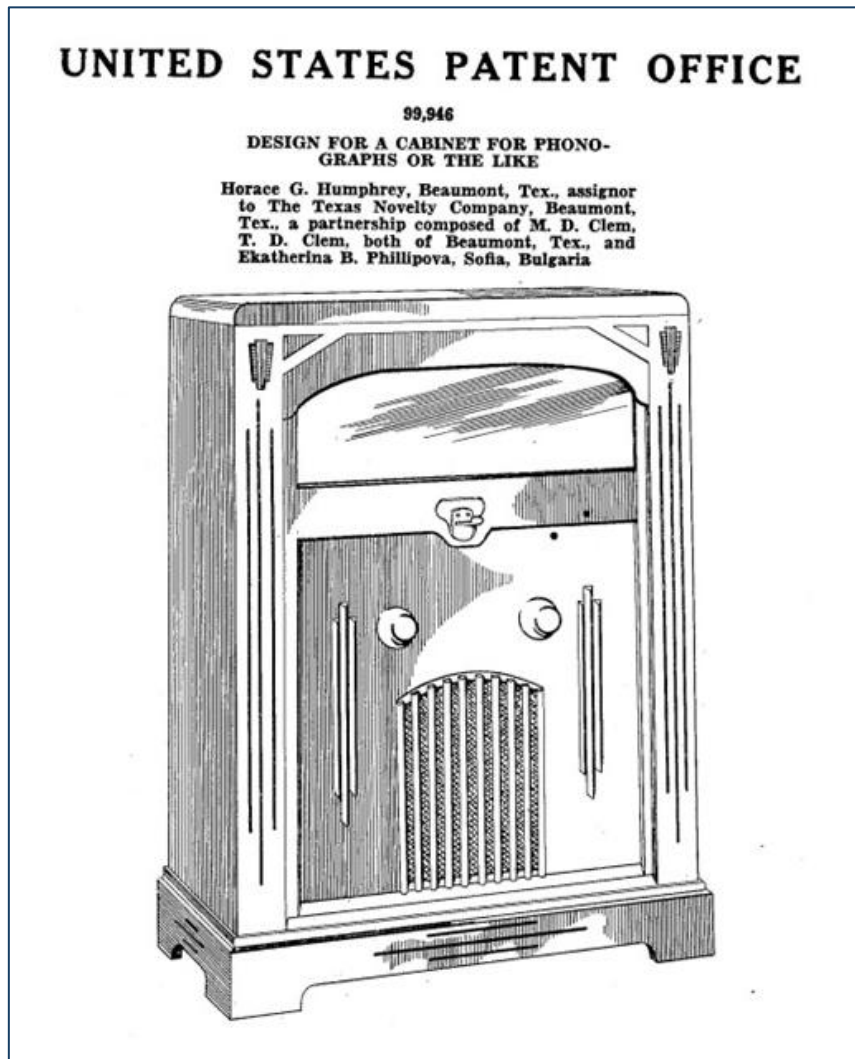
established a new company Sabine Novelty Co. based in Many in Louisiana. Theodore owned the Sabine Novelty Co. until 1960, then sold it to Martha C. Foshee (1929-2021), but remained with the company as a mechanic until he passed away in 1969.


However, it is uncertain what happened to the original Texas Novelty Co, after Michael D. Clem passed away in 1970, and information would be appreciated. The grave markers of all three brothers can be found at the Magnolia Cemetery in Beaumont, but the interment details of sister Ekatherina (*Katherine*) are unfortunately unknown.
